GOP STATE CONVENTION DEBRIEF

I think the State convention went very well and most are pleased with the 4 people elected to the State Party: Jeff Dewitt – chairman, Christine Ong Cothrun – Secretary, Elijah Norton – Treasurer, and Robert Canterbury – Sgt at Arms.

One tidbit of information I just learned on voter data from Maricopa County is that while the independent registered voters are the largest group in Maricopa County by .4% at 34.9%, Republican

voters outnumber democrats with Republicans at 34.5% and Democrats at 29.7%. It is clear we need to work hard everywhere to turn out the Republican vote while making the case to Independents they need to vote conservative to save our State and Country.

OTHER NEWS

At our next GOP PC meeting we will be making sure each committee has a chair and picking dates for the first meeting for each committee. GOP HQ can be used for the meetings.
