Good day, everyone! I wanted to send everyone a follow-up email to recap a few things that we covered during our open meeting on 24 January 2023. As I promised, we are striving to increase and improve communication, so please take a look at this important information, whether you attended the meeting or not.

In regards to the PC committees that Chairman Greg introduced during the 9 January 2023 meeting, I'd like to reiterate that these are just the beginning. We will have more committees introduced later this year. Our goal was to first follow and pay attention to our responsibilities as Precinct Committeemen as per our bylaws. Please see attached bylaws, Article III, Section 2 (p.8). The six committees that we are starting with are:

1. Young Republican Group
2. Hispanic Outreach Committee
3. Voter Registration Committee
4. Fundraising Committee
5. 'Get Out the Vote' Committee (multi-phase approach: clean voter roles, canvas, analyze data, etc)
6. Poll Observer / County Election Vote Counting Committee

Important notes:

- You must be a PC to lead the committees, but do not have to be a PC to be a part of the committees.
- The GOP HQ office is open to be used for these committees to meet (just double check that one of us with keys is available to open and close the facility).
- You can join more than one committee and move around until you find your perfect niche, but in order to adhere to our bylaws, **please join at least one committee.**

Regarding our 5-prong approach to recruiting more PCs, please note what those are:

5. Adopt lonely precincts (precincts that currently have only one or no PCs)
