



Greg Wilkinson

Yuma County GOP Chairman

A Minnesota native, Greg was 1st stationed at MCAS Yuma in 1980 by the United States Marine Corps. After serving 22 years working with missile systems and Joint Operations, Greg Wilkinson retired as a Lieutenant Colonel and the Commanding Officer of MACS1 in 2000 making Yuma his permanent home.

He spent the next 20 years working for the City of Yuma first as an Assistant Director of Information Technology, and most recently as the City Administrator from which he retired after serving close to 10 years.

Greg has served on numerous Yuma community organization boards including the Greater Yuma Economic Development Council (GYEDC), Yuma County Intergovernmental Public Transit Authority Board (YCIPTA), Southwestern Arizona Futures Forum, and Yuma50 a military advocacy group, to name a few. Greg was elected twice to serve on Yuma Elementary School District #1 Governing Board where he served as Board President for 6 years.

Since 2002 Greg has served as the Chairman of the Southern Regional Advisory Council for the Department of Homeland Security, to which he has been appointed by the past three Arizona governors.

Since retiring as City Administrator in 2019, Greg started his own consulting company Archixona, LLC, a Service Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business (SDVOSB). Archixona provides consulting services to the US Department of Homeland Security on cyber and emergency communications systems and constructional materials for federal projects. Greg's efforts as a community leader have been recognized locally and nationally including awards from the Arizona Association of Public Safety Communications Officers (AZ APCO) and the W2I Wireless Internet Institute for advancing wireless communications and emergency responders' communication interoperability in Yuma County. Most recently Greg was selected by his peers in public administration as the recipient of the Gabe Zimmerman Public Service Community Builder Award in 2016.

In December 2022 Greg was elected by the Yuma County Republican Party as Chairman. Greg's goal is to implement an aggressive program to ensure Republicans turn out the vote and win in November 2024.
